Breathing. His breathing exercises involve hyperventilation and breath-holding while being exposed to cold conditions. Whether that is a cold shower or an ice bath, this technique helps practitioners tolerate the icy discomfort, making it easier to reap the benefits of cold exposure. Hof's followers have claimed for this breathing exercise to be life changing, and rightfully so. Not only does this method help clear the mind and reduce anxiety and depression, which is what

many of us need right now, but it has also been proven to promote weight loss and immunity, delay Hof was shot full of endotoxins by scientists, and because he was following his staple way of breathing, his body did not have an immune response, such as a fever or septic shock causing organ failure This is because his body has built up such a strong immune system from his meditation that he is now able to resist disease much more effectively. While The Iceman has posted guided meditations on YouTube and on his app, WHM, here is a step-by-step practice:

- 1. Get into a cold environment, or simply lie on your back. 2. Force yourself to hyperventilate as you take up to 40 deep breaths through the nose and out through the mouth.

 - 4. Inhale to full capacity and hold for another 15 seconds, then exhale.
 - 5. Repeat this process three to four times and enjoy the resulting state of deep relaxation and contentment.

By controlling our autonomic nervous system, which involves subconscious processes like breathing and temperature regulation, we also take control of our thoughts, health, and joy. Instead

your life, you should improve your mental health with this technique and watch your worries defrost with every breath you take. So, relax, submerge yourself in some ice water, channel your inner Wim Hof, and just breathe. You can and will get past this stressful hurdle.

History of Valentines Day



this year, I spent a lot of time looking at the different requirements and criteria colleges use to evaluate students.

Schools like Georgetown require students to submit all previous SAT and ACT scores when they apply. I think that more schools should adopt this model to have a better understanding of grade inflation by school. However, students who wouldn't have wanted to submit their scores should have more consideration allocated to other parts of their allocation, so they still have an equal chance of admission.

The British system for applying to college, called UCAS, does have testing requirements. While they don't have an SAT equivalent, universities have A-Level requirements for students to matriculate that are very similar to APs. In fact, universities publish which A-Level scores they require to get into majors within their school. Because criteria are so rigid, UCAS only lets students apply to five schools, a sharp contrast to Common

Applying to college App's 20 (plus schools like the UCs, which aren't on Common App). Additionally, no British schools use supplemental essays for admission. They only have the personal statement, which explains why you chose your first choice major. The structure of this process encourages meritocracy and makes the college process easier for students, particularly when they're high-achieving in high school. Students enter the admissions process with a clear view of their capacities, and a realistic expectation for their acceptances. This is a sharp contrast to the American system, where decisions are relatively arbitrary because of the sheer number of qualified students applying to each school. Students who have consistently done well in high school are practically guaranteed admission to a top university. In contrast, the most qualified of applicants could get rejected from every top university in America.

tracurriculars in your personal statement, there's no activity section. This allows students to focus on pursuing the topics they're actually interested in rather than starting clubs with no point, something many high school students do to look like a leader in their community, or pursuing extracurriculars they are not interested in in an effort to appear more qualified to colleges. This forces students to prioritize their time, and to spend time developing their genuine interests, which will be reflected in higher test scores.

Lastly, I do not support legacy considerations in the college admissions process. I understand that many students want to go to the same university as other members of the family have, but that does not automatically guarantee qualification no matter how much the family may donate. Colleges' continued evaluation of legacy status is antithetical to their commitments towards inclusion, reflected in things like test-optional policies that seek to level the playing field for applicants.







n the tragic events of October 7th, Hamas, a Palestinian Islamic militant group, fired at least 3,000 rockets in the early morning into the Gaza envelope of Israel. This territory exists about 4 miles from the borders of the Gaza

Strip and is populated by around 70,000 Israelis. Hamas fighters then breached the Gaza-Israel barrier and proceeded into Israeli neighborhoods and military bases, killing at least 1,200 people and kidnapping around 250 soldiers and civilians, 30 of whom are children, to be held in Gaza.

This act of violence sparked outrage across the world on both sides of the conflict, with some denouncing it as an act of terrorism and calling for the complete annihilation of the Gaza Strip. Some blame the Israeli occupation of Palestinian territories as the root cause of the attack. Whatever opinion you may have about the conflict, it is important to understand the history of the two nations, and how this conflict came to be. The ancient land of Palestine was one of the earliest regions in the world to see human habagricultural practices, and civilization and is the birthplace of Christianity and Judaism. Contrary to popular

An Honest Look at the Israeli-Palestinian **Conflict**

belief that the Israelites were the first group to inhabit Palestine, it was actually the Canaanites during the Bronze Age who were the first to develop independent city-states in the region. Later, during the Iron Age,

most of Palestine was ruled by the two Israelite kingdoms, Israel and Judah, while the Philistines occupied its southern coast. The Assyrians conquered the region in the 8th century BCE, followed by the Babylonians in 601 BCE, and followed by the Persians in 539 BCE. Following the conquering of Palestine in the 2nd century BCE by the Hasmonean Kingdom, the kingdom eventually became part of Rome and was annexed by the Romans in 63 BCE. In the 4th century after the birth of Jesus Christ, the Roman Empire began to transition to Christianity, and Palestine became a hub for Christianity and attracted monks, pilgrims, and scholars. Following several Muslim conquests that wrestled control of Palestine, in the 13th century, the Egyptian Mamluks reunified their control of Palestine following the invasion of the Mongol empire, which the Ottoman Empire then conquered in the 16th century, and was ruled as Ottoman Syria until the 20th century.

After the disbandment of the Ottoman Empire after World War I, the victorious European countries divided Turkish-ruled regions into new states and gave the Western countries control of them.

Palestine was put under British control under the League of Nations Mandate. In 1947, after the Holocaust left millions of Jewish refugees displaced and unable to return to their home countries, the United Nations agreed to terminate the British Mandate for Palestine and recommended the partition of Palestine into one Arab and one Jewish state to resolve the refugee crisis as well as address the conflicting objectives and claims to the Mandate territory by the two major factions: the Zionist movement and the Arab-Nationalist movement.

About a year after the UN resolution, large-scale fighting between Arab and Jewish communities in Palestine, which resulted in the 1948 Nakba (translated literally as 'The Catastrophe'), during which dozens of massacres targeting Arabs were administered, and over 400 Arab-populated towns and villages were either destroyed or repopulated by Jewish settlers and given Hebrew names. About 750,000 Palestinians, which was about half of Palestine's Arab population at the time, were forced to flee from their homes or were forcibly removed by Zionist militias. The approximate 156,000 Palestinians that remained within the borders of Israel became internally displaced persons or were forced to relocate to the Gaza Strip which was under Egyptian jurisdiction, or the West Bank which was annexed by Jordan in 1950. In 1987, Hamas was created after the first Palestinian uprising, and in 2006 won the Palestinian Legislative Election by campaigning for Palestinian armed resistance against the Israeli occupation. now, in 2024 things only gotten worse for the Palestinian people.

It's important to remember that the Gaza Strip is about 25 miles long and about 8 miles wide, making it about the size of Houston and housing more than 2 million people, leading to a density of more than 5,800 people per square kilometer. 43.5% of people living in Gaza are 14 years old or younger, the median age being 18, which makes more than half of Gaza's population children. Israel declared war on October 9th, 2023, and imposed a "total blockage" of Gaza. Israeli Defense Minister



Yoav Gallant was quoted saying "There will be no electricity, no food, no fuel, everything is closed. We are fighting human animals and we are acting accordingly." Since the start of the Israel-Hamas war, the death toll in Gaza has surpassed 26,000, with more than 64,000 wounded, and 1.7 million displaced. In December 2023, Israel flooded the Hamas tunnel network with salt water, the same tunnels where a majority of the Israeli hostages were held, which contaminated the drinking water in Gaza and damaged the already weak agriculture. In January 2024, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu rejected Hamas' proposal to release all remaining Israeli hostages in exchange for Israel to withdraw its forces from Gaza, releasing all Palestinian hostages, and ending the violence against Palestinians. Netanyahu's refusal to compromise put him against his own War Cabinet, who say the only way to meet their goal of releasing all the hostages is to agree to a ceasefire. Israel's attack on Gaza is not a matter of self-defense or about rescuing the hostages, it is an act of genocide and ethnic cleansing.


Girls Soccer Updates

The Leap Into Court

Vegas Judge Mary Kay Holthus, was jumped during a sentence hearing, by Deobra Redden. To start from the beginning, Redden had been scheduled to be sentenced due to a charge of attempted battery with substantial bodily harm. And before the attack, a prosecutor had stated that Redden has had a history of violent crimes and requested for a prison term; some of Redden past charges included home invasion, domestic violence and battery on a protected person.

Speaking for himself, Redden had claimed that he was "in a better place in my mind," and that he had a better support system with a new job. He made claims that he shouldn't be sent to prison, also adding

Redden's attorney had also testified for a suspended sentence, referring to past completions of probation programs, his mental health history and background. Holthus had acknowledged this, but claimed that she thought he had a liking for something else, and that she couldn't get with his history. At this, Redden had sworn at the judge and jumped over the bench and began his assault on Judge Holthus.

One witness of this rush was Lasso, who said he'd only been clerking for Judge Holthus for a few months, who claimed that he originally thought Redden had made a break for the door, but quickly realized that was not Redden's plan.

Moments later, Lasso said that a correction officer had made it over to the bench to apprehend Redden; seeing this, Lasso had stepped back to allow the officers to do their job, assuming that it was under control. He then said that after Redden had realized what was going

He said that "After the de- on, he switched the judge onto and officers had escorted her out the correctional officer, and it had taken multiple people to eventually get Redden to stop.

> Eventually an alarm had been activated and Redden could be heard yelling as people checked on Judge Holthus. One of the court marshals could also be seen holding something to his head. Holthus was eventually able to stand after a few minutes,

of the courtroom before ordering all of the other defendants out.

2024 Fashion Predictions



Becoming Your Authentic Self



Despite finishing with the worst record of his coaching career, his resume is nothing short of excellent. At the beginning of his career, Belichick secured two superbowl victories with the New York Giants as a defensive coordinator; one in '86 and the other in '90. After gaining some experience coaching the Browns, the Patriots, and the Jets, Belichick set sail for a long journey of success. His tenure with New England lasted 24 seasons, earning him 17 AFC East division titles, 13 AFC championship appearances and 6 super bowls victories. Not only is he
